This is a reminder to complete your **FASTING BLOOD WORK** at least **ONE WEEK** before your upcoming appointment. You may also be asked to give a urine sample as part of your doctors' lab orders.

Having these tests done before your appointment allows your physician to discuss the results with you at the time of your visit.

NOTES TO BE PREPARED FOR YOUR BLOODWORK:

- You should be <u>fasting</u> for at least 8-10 hours. Fasting means, nothing to eat or drink during that time, except for water, black coffee, or tea. No cream or sugar.
- Take your medications as usual the day of your bloodwork.
- Your lab order will be sent to Quest Diagnostics Lab unless we are instructed otherwise. If you
 prefer to have your blood drawn at another facility, you <u>MUST</u> inform our office (if you have not previously
 done so) as soon as possible so we can send the order.
- Please be mindful of any lab you choose as each location may have specific days/hours and rules.
 - O At this time, Quest Diagnostics Lab located in our building at 11 Old Park Lane Road is by APPOINTMENT ONLY. Note: Appointments at this location book up quickly, so please schedule your appointment when you receive this letter.
